▼ SITUATION

Faced with a world wounded by wars and violence, where the earth is exhausted by ecological degradation, and where women, men, and children are forced to leave their lands as victims of trafficking and multiple forms of exploitation and deprivation, we become aware that human and environmental crises are deeply interconnected.

As social, political, and economic inequalities widen, as solidarity weakens, and as human and spiritual values erode, our planet and our hearts gradually become deserts. Human dignity, fundamental rights, and the integrity of all creation are gravely threatened. In contemplating this reality, we turn to God to entrust to Him the suffering of the earth and its peoples, and to ask for the grace of an integral ecological conversion, capable of restoring justice, peace, and fraternity among all living beings.



REFLECTION

Laudato Si' reminds us that the current crises in our world, listed above, constitute a single socio-environmental crisis where the suffering of the earth joins that of the poorest.

The JPIC-ED mission helps us understand that the exploitation of creation and of people shares the same root: the rupture of relationships with God, with others, and with the earth. Faced with this reality, we are called to an integral ecological conversion, which transforms our mindsets, our choices, and our ways of life.

Therefore, as MSOLA, our commitment to JPIC-ED is not a secondary commitment, but an essential dimension of our Christian faith.

By uniting prayer and action, we are invited to become artisans of justice, peace, and reconciliation, and responsible guardians of the common home, for today and for future generations.
